May 6, 1943, I was sworn in to the WAC in San Francisco, CA. My home was 365 miles North of San Francisco.

On June 23, 1943, I received orders to report to San Francisco on June 25, 1943 at 9:00 AM.

I reported on time and was bussed from San Francisco to Oakland, CA to catch the Santa Fe train for the trip to Fort Des Moines, IA for Basic Training along with some other recruits.

I'll never forget that five days and four nights on that dirty, hot, train. I ran out of meal tickets by the time I arrived in Kansas City and then had to pay for my own lunch on the Super Train (the Rocket) from there to Des Moines. Meal tickets were \$1 for each meal.

We were a pretty crummy looking bunch by the time we got to Des Moines.

We were met at the Des Moines Depot by Army trucks and had our first ride in those lovely vehicles from there to the Post. I believe that I'll never forget our first army meal - half cooked baked beans! The is all they had left that night and the is what we had for our dinner. We were assigned bunks and told to make them. Then we hade all the bunks in that big building. Also to make them right as there would be inspection the next morning.

I was assigned to Co. 16, Regt. 3 at Boom Town on July 5, 1943. There we learned how to march, do K.P. and many other things. I'll never forget the field kitchen on a rainy day.

August 3, 1943 about 5000 of us gathered, sat on the grass and listened to Col. Hobby speak to us. The next morning we all marched to the parade ground and

were sworn into the WAC. That is one of my fondest memories.

August 19 found us leaving

Ft. Des Moines and I was on my way to Hdq. 3rd Air Force in Tampa, Florida. I arrived in Tampa on August 22, 1943 and there I stayed until I was discharged on November 16, 1945. My years in Tampa were very interesting and educational. I made many friends and still keep in touch with many of them.

July 1, 1978 a group of 3rd Air Force WACS met in Tampa for four days and we had a wonderful reunion. I have many memories of my years in Tampa. Most of them good. I was made a PFC in Oct. 1943, Corporal in Feb, 1944 and Sargent in Oct. 1945. My office, Eng. Section, had a way of filling positions with some one back from overseas instead of with local people. So the Sgt. Stripes took a long time.

My Husband, Ernest E. McBain, was in the Navy SeaBees and he visited Tampa on two leaves. He was out one month before I received my discharge at Camp Beale, CA. He passed away on October 15, 1973. I have one daughter, two grandchildren, and I great granddaughter. I am retired from the State of California. I worked for the Department of Public Works, Div. Of Highways for nineteen years.

We start by making our polymer clay cane and then we make our beads, and sometimes their matching pendants out of this cane, but unlike some companies who offer you cane beads that are only thin slices with filler in the middle our cane beads are solid cane all the way through!

Once our focal beads are done we use the remaining cane to roll our accent beads as well, this technique makes for some stunning accents on your jewelry! We then shop around for just the right spacer beads and findings, and after many hours of hard work... voila... one of a kind, unique, eye catching jewelry that you're sure to treasure for a lifetime!

We also have many craft items that we sell such as sculptures, figurines, and the occasional pinestraw basket or ceramic figure. And we haven't forgotten our little men and ladies out there, there's a special section just for them!

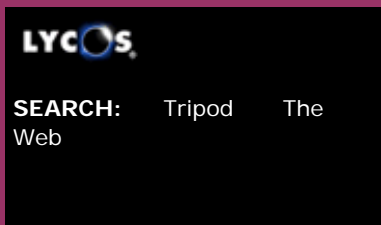
